This week in Year 6!

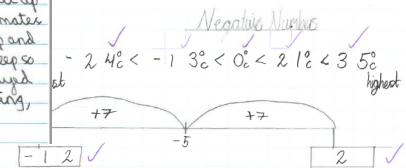
