Topics this week- Autumn, ordinal numbers and phonics.

- What happens to the trees in Autumn? Create a piece of art showing an autumn tree. What other changes take place in Autumn? Can you write about these?
- Practise writing your ordinal numbers- 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th etc. Race your toys or family members. Who will come third (3rd)? You could make a line of toys, family members. Who is 2nd in the line?
- Practise writing this weeks phonics graphemes **ur, ear, air and er**. How many words can you think of that use the graphemes?

Reading Books

Your child has received a reading book that has been carefully selected for them. Inside the book you will find a bookmark on how to care for the book. Please read with your child at least 3 times a week.

First time- **Decoding**- Follow instructions on the inside of the front cover. Then read the book.

Second time – **Prosody**- Read the book again. Focus on the children reading fluently and with expression.

Third time- **Comprehension**- Read book again and answer questions listed on the back cover.

If you have any questions about reading books then you can ask at parents evenings.
