Maths

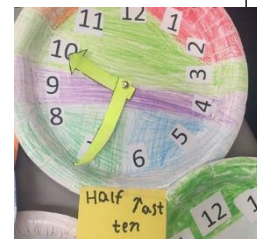
Keep doing your SPARX!



We are working on learning to tell the time!

Practise telling the time to the nearest quarter of an hour – extend this to the nearest 5 minutes if your child is confident and you feel they are ready.
