### Science

Our topic this term is *Materials*. Can you go on a hunt around your house and / or garden to see how many different types of material you can find? Can you spot things made from plastic, glass, fabric, wood, metal or brick? Talk to your adult about why they may have been made from this material. Could you have a pair of socks made from metal? What about a tea pot made from fabric?! Why?!



### English

We have been looking at *prepositions* this week as part of our work on Duckie's Rainbow. Can you put yourself – or a favourite toy – in a variety of places and use sentences with prepositions to describe where they are? *Ted is in front of the door*. Here are some prepositions that you could try: *next to, in front of, behind, above, below, alongside, through, under, over, around, across, beside, beneath*.



*Where else do you think Duckie could have gone on his journey?*

**Maths:** We are currently brushing up on our skills and understanding in the area of Place Value. You can support your child with this at home by encouraging them to:

- Count up and back confidently to 100, starting from any given number
- Read and write numbers to 100 (check for reversal)
- Partition numbers into tens and ones (52 = 5 tens and 2 ones).
- Use sticks to represent tens and stones to represent ones. The children can then make a variety of numbers for you, as in the picture above.
