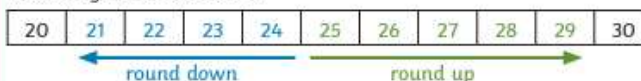

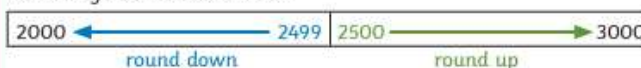

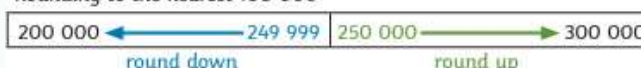
Rounding to the nearest 10
