Read for at least ten minutes every day. Don't forget to jot down what you've read in your reading journal and hand this to your teacher on **Mondays**.

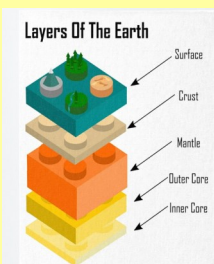

This week, we have learned about the different layers of the Earth.

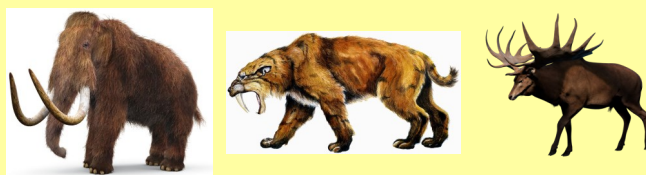
How could you represent the inner core, outer core, mantle and crust?

## Maths

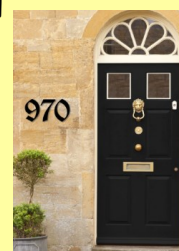
We have been learning about place value.
