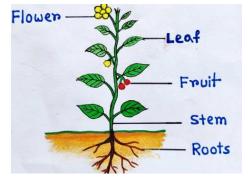


You could also try these activities too:

2) In Science, we are learning about plants. We have been looking at what plants need in order to be able to grow and be healthy. Why not go on a plant hunt around the garden, park or anywhere with plants! Sketch the different plants you see and label them. Are they all the same? How are they different? Do they all look healthy? If not, why do you think this might be? If you are able to, try carefully to lift the plant out of the soil to look at the roots. Maybe you could try to create an a-z of plants, flowers or trees
