*Can you tell your adult why it is important to not give up?*

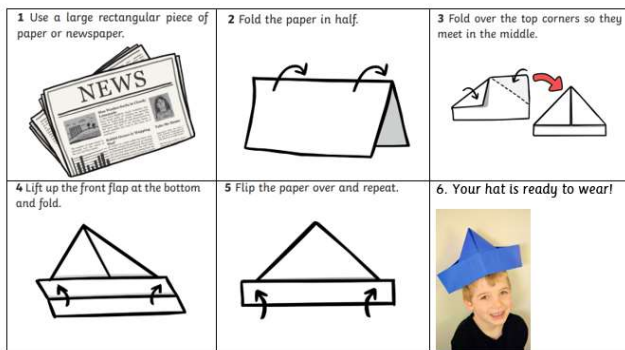
*Can you remember the words to our new song 'Have a go'?*
