an entertaining way.

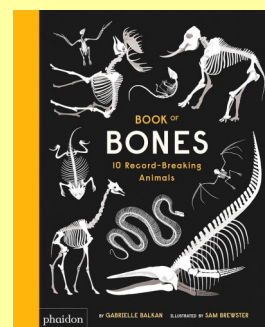
Can you guess which animals these are about?

Maths

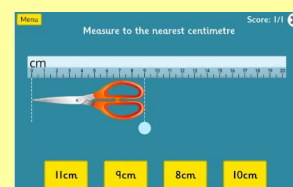
In Maths, we have continued our learning about length and perimeter. Have a go at these
