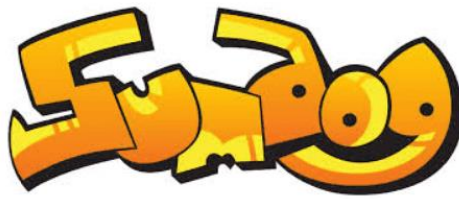
We are learning new spelling patterns every week.

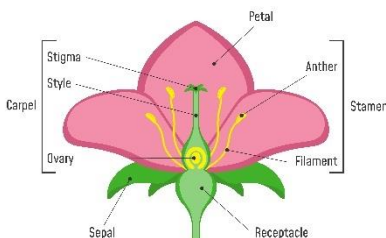


You could also try these activities too:
