Geography

The children have really enjoyed learning about the Rainforests as part of our Geography topic this term. This week for Home Learning, choose something about the Rainforests that you find interesting and find out more about it. It might be the different layers, or the animals that live there – or the ways that we can protect our rainforests and help to slow down climate change. You can show us what you have learnt in any way that you like: a poster, a powerpoint, a fact file, by asking someone to film you talking about it, or even by making a model. Enjoy!



Maths

We are starting to explore money in our maths sessions. Please support your child by looking at coins at home and making sure that they understand the value of each one. You could set up a shop and encourage them to ‘pay’ for items. Start off with single coin amounts (50p, 20p etc) and then move on to combine coins to make simple amounts. (35p = 3 x 10p and a 5p).

If they are already super-whizzy and this, you could try working with them to give change from £1. Have a fun!
