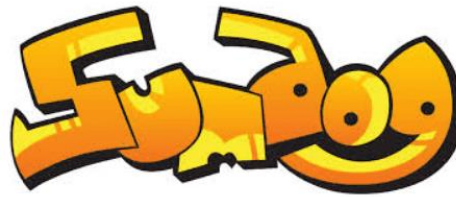
We are learning new spelling patterns every week.

Remember to read at home regularly (at least 10 minutes a day) and hand in reading diaries on Mondays to be checked- you could get a "Read to Succeed" ticket and win a book!

You could also try these activities too:

- 1) For Geography our topic is 'villages, towns and cities'. Can you think of different places around the world for each letter of the alphabet then label what they are? These could also be countries and continents. You could even challenge yourself to think of more than one place for each letter. For example: A-Austria (country) Antwerp (city). Try find these places on a globe, atlas or map.



- 2) In Mathematics we are learning about length and perimeter. Do you have a ruler, tape measure or anything else to measure things with at home? Have a look at the millimetres and centimetres. Then, find some items around your house that you would like to measure. Before measuring, estimate the length first. How close was your estimate to the exact length? Write down a list of things you measure with the estimate and exact measurements. Can you write down both the millimetres and the centimetres?
